Call

Take independent call starting second year covering all modalities. Attendings on call at home at night as backup with an in-house attending reading plain films until 9PM on weekdays.

2nd Year: 4 weeks of night float, 4 weeks evening, 4

weeks of short call

3rd/4th year: 2 weeks of night float, 2 weeks

evening, 2 weeks of short call

First year: Completely free the first 6 months.

Buddy call begins in January, covering the short call

shift with an upper year resident.

Weekends: Friday night, Saturday day, Sunday day shifts divided up amongst call pool. ~12 shifts 2nd

year, 8 3rd year, 4 4th year. Holiday Call: Covered by 2nd years.

Time Away

Vacation: 20 days/year, can be flexibly scheduled. Holidays: Covered by 2nd years, all others have them off.

Conferences: Academic time for conferences

supported.

Comp days: When covering the weekend plain film day shifts (both weekend days), get 2 weekdays off to be used within 2 weeks.

Interview days: 5 days.
