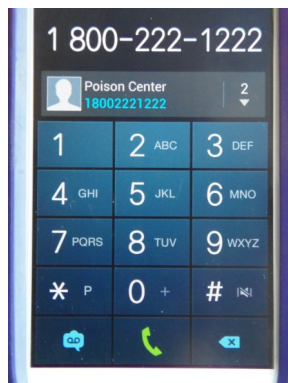


## Northern New England Poison Center
