## Indeterminate COVID-19 Results Run on the Hologic Panther Platform at UVMMC

In order to decrease the risk of reporting false positive COVID-19 results from the Panther, the laboratory will be repeating low level positive samples (Ct values >/= 37) on the same sample. If the repeat test is positive, the final result will be reported as positive. If the repeat test is negative, the final result will be indeterminate.

## Indeterminate results could mean:

- Low level virus near the limit of detection of the assay (very early or very late infection)
- Contamination of the sample with low level virus at some point in the process
- Nonspecific amplification

Repeat sample collection and testing should be considered for patients with COVID-19 symptoms and in patients with a history of a high-risk exposure.
