# Preparing for Your Weight Loss Surgery

**Events Leading up to surgery** 

The initial step to determining if you are a candidate for weight loss surgery begins with an evaluation of your health questionnaire. If you meet the requirements, the following must be met for insurance approval:

- New Patient Informational Meeting
- Psychological evaluation (45 mins)
- Initial consultation with surgeon and dietician (1 hour)
- EGD (Upper Endoscopy) and Upper GI (Full day)
- Second visit with Surgeon to review testing (30 mins)
- Meet with Physicians Assistant (1 hour)
- Post-Op Nutrition Class (8am-11:30am)
- Behavioral Skills Class (10:30am-12)
- Weight Loss Support Group (6pm-7pm)
- Monthly visits with a provider and dietician until all requirements have been met (the amount of visits could vary) (45 mins each visit)
- Submission to insurance company
- Surgery date chosen, History and Physical scheduled
